Building Our Future Together

Our new programs building will help us reach more, do more, and save more lives.

Build the future with us!



Over the last 70 years, the support of our community has encouraged Southern Pines to become the animal welfare organization we are today—an innovative leader in lifesaving.

While our current office has met our needs over the years by providing a space for our lifesaving programs, we have greatly outgrown this space. Our building is operating way over-capacity and is hindering our ability to grow and better meet the needs of the people and pets of our community. A new building to house all of our lifesaving programs—foster, community resources, adoptions, medical, behavior, volunteer, and transport—will provide all of our vital programs the room to expand so that Southern Pines can continue to be an effective community partner in animal lifesaving for decades to come.

Your support and your donations have already played a major role in transforming Southern Pines into a place of hope and second chances. Not only pets in need, but for people as well. We wanted to extend an invitation to join us on the next phase of our journey--building a future of compassion, community, and collaboration together.

Initial estimates from our building company indicate that a new programs facility and associated costs will total around \$750,000. The need is great and necessary. Our current building is greatly limiting our ability to help the people and pets who need us, and our staff need more space to do their lifesaving work.

This new building will more than double our current program space and will give us ample space for future growth. Will you partner with us once again, and help us build this critical new addition to our shelter campus that will enable us to reach more, do more, and save more lives?

When Jennifer adopted her dog Ali (the fluffy, scruffy gray pup pictured) from Southern Pines in 2008, she became more aware of the state of animal welfare in Southern Mississippi and the daily challenges that both animals in need and shelter staff face. As she fostered, volunteered and became more involved with the shelter, she also realized that the successful, happy new beginnings we all wish for our shelter cats and dogs are only achievable when we all work together.

"Over the last 10 years, as I've seen our community become more informed and more involved in helping the shelter, I've gotten to see Southern Pines grow into the place it is today," says Jennifer.

Today, because of supporters like Jennifer, Southern Pines is one of the largest openadmission shelters in Mississippi to reach no-kill status; saving over 4,000 animals every year and helping to find those homeless cats and dogs loving, forever homes.

Kennel Sponsorship Program

(Shelter)

When you or your organization become the sponsor of a kennel at Southern Pines, you are playing a vital role in the day-to-day care of animals in need, helping us continue to provide basic care —food, housing, medical care—to all the animals who will stay in your sponsored kennel over the course of 12 months.

As a kennel sponsor you will receive a 5"x7" plaque that will be affixed to your sponsored kennel for 12 months, recognizing the way you're making a difference for homeless and at-risk cats and dogs. Plaques may be personalized with your name, organizational logo, and/or a logo; or may be personalized in honor or in memory of a friend, loved one or pet. You will also receive one Facebook post a year, highlighting an animal who's staying in your sponsored kennel and highlighting your/your organization's contribution that's making a daily difference for them.



Dorothy Ricks Community Cat Fund

This fund assists with the cost of fixing community cats. With the Dorothy Ricks Community Cat Fund, we hope to honor her memory by continuing her legacy of love for community cats, her commitment to the mission of Southern Pines, and her passion to make her community a better place.

This fund makes the following programs possible:

- Tomcat Tuesday Taking place on the first Tuesday of the month*, our Tomcat Tuesday special helps to make neuter surgery more accessible to owned male cats in our community.**
 - A \$1,500 gift makes one Tomcat Tuesday event possible and helps 50 cats
 - A \$12,000 gift makes Tomcat Tuesday possible for a whole year and helps 600
- Community Cat TNR The Dorothy Ricks Community Cat Fund also helps to offset a portion of surgery fees for outdoor community cat, as well as any incidental charges that may occur*, and lowers the cost of community cat surgeries to just \$35 per cat for the client.*
 - A \$20 gift makes one discounted community cat surgery possible
- Free To Be This fund helps to make spay and neuter services free to Hattiesburg residents who are trying to help community cats in their neighborhoods. The cats are fixed, rabies vaccinated, and then placed back in the neighborhood they came from to promote healthier, more stable community cat colonies.
 - · A \$55 gift helps cover the cost of one Hattiesburg community cat surgery
- Spay-a-thon Taking place on World Spay Day, this annual event discounts spay surgery for up to 200 female cats, preventing unwanted kitten litters, promoting a healthier cat population, and helping to ease the burden on local shelters.**
 - · A \$250 gift helps us to fix 10 cats
 - A \$1,000 gift helps 40 cats receive surgery
 - A \$5,000 gift helps to fund the entire event to help 200 cats***

* This program is not currently grant-funded and is dependent entirely on community donations. Our offsite clinics take our wellness services into our local neighborhoods, making vital veterinary care even more accessible to the people and pets who need them.

 A \$3,500 gift makes it possible for 100 pets to receive a free basic exam, parvo vaccine, and rabies vaccine at one of our Paw-Pup Clinics

One cold and rainy afternoon,

a little kitty showed up at Sherry's back door. Douglas, as the kitten came to be named, seemed to be suffering from a kitty cold with a stuffy nose and only had energy for sleeping and eating. Sherry quickly scheduled a wellness appointment for Douglas with our clinic team so he could get an exam and scanned for a microchip. After several rounds of antibiotics and nose drops failed to improve his condition, our veterinarian suspected Douglas had a polyp that was affecting his breathing and sure enough, they discovered a marble-sized mass in his nose.

"The Southern Pines vets and staff provided wonderful Sherry. "They care," says prescribed antibiotics nose drops, did his neuter surgery and vaccinations, and removed a polyp from his nose. After a few days [at the clinic]—with phone calls every day to let us know how he was doing-he was released to come home. Since he had no identifying chip, he home with us to stay."


