



Kitten Gruel Recipe

- one 3.0 ounce can of kitten food (this is the small sized cans)
- two tablespoons of breeder's edge or KMR
- two tablespoons of water
- one tablespoon of karo

Put all ingredients straight into a blender and blend for several seconds until smooth. The best gruel is made using a blender but you can also use a fork, whisk, or blender bottle to blend your mixture together. Gruel can be stored for up to 24 hours in the refrigerator and should be warmed before serving to kittens.

To make the gruel even more appetizing, microwave for 7-10 seconds and stir. This will make the gruel smell stronger and entice even the pickiest kittens.

You can customize your gruel to best suit your kitten. For kittens with anemia you can add more karo. For younger, pickier kittens you can try adding more powdered formula. For kittens that are having trouble staying hydrated you can substitute the water in the recipe for plain, flavorless pedialyte.
